

SATU MARE MILLENNIAL CITY

Satu Mare is a city of residence of the county with the same name, situated in NW Romania crossroads between the three countries. It is 12 km from the border with Hungary and 27 km from Ukraine. Stable population of the city is 115,142 inhabitants increased by over 4,000 people with jobs in town, or who attend classes at different school teaching.

On the nationalities are: Romanian 58.49%, 34.98% Hungarians, Germans 3.64%, 2.89% other nationalities of more than 300 Roma families with 2300 members representing approximately 2.48%.

SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS - Politics - COMMUNITY FOR A SAFER ROAD TRAFFIC

We live in a period of rapid change. All are put before us challenges to adapt to a world that no longer is as safe and predictable as time era, and in terms of child growth and maturation are more difficult than they were before.

In this context, traffic is more intense because of the increasing performance of vehicles attracting permanent "speeders" which often defies the highway code. Thus primary pupils are most exposed to traffic accidents on public roads. Of these cases, statistics inform us that annual nearly 250 children aged up to 14 years, lose their lives in road traffic accidents and over 1500 are injured.

"Any person regardless of age, sex or profession, who go on foot, on a public road is pedestrian" - sounds like the definition of its road.

All statistics show that most road traffic accidents occurred within hours 12.00 - 18.00 well 40.7% of their total hours that coincide with the entry or exit of students from school.

Thus approximately 60% of them are due to irregular crossing of the street.

In Satu Mare in 2007 - 2008 there were 66 road accidents involving:

- 4 deaths
- 33 seriously injured
- 29 slightly wounded.

World Health Organization forecast that road accidents will be the third cause of deaths and injuries worldwide by 2020, children being the most affected in this regard.

Experience has shown that students, due to the desire to impose collective attention by risk attitude of the "bravado", the direct cause accidents, some very serious track. Whatever the cause determined by the police, there is only one culprit: lack of education made the long road.

School, family and the entire community must help to protect children from accidents by promoting activities on the knowledge and compliance with traffic rules and conduct preventive and permanent forms of modern methods and means of transmission of knowledge, so that they are treated in a pleasant, fast and thoroughly by children.

Effort to educate, is perhaps the most eloquent expression of hope that people's future is possible and trust that the investment of time, energy and means in education is an investment in the long term effect, but guaranteed. Providing a sound education, help children to find that smile can salute the future.

In conclusion road education should start at the young age for the purpose of training and development of a citizen who applies a correct behavior in traffic and life in general.

Road education in school and family in preparing children for life. Therefore requires a real partnership between school - family - police-community. So parents, teachers, police officers may organize joint activities, collaborative curriculum projects, is supported each other in fulfilling roles.

Shares her family working as a mediator between students, school and police. Therefore school must meet its educational obligations for the transmission of cultural patterns and social status.

The most successful activities were competitions organized on the road at preschoolers and schoolers with collaboration Police Inspectorate and Satu Mare County School Inspectorate.

14 April 2008 was held the " PRESCHOOLERS CAN MOVE CORRECTLY" which was attended by crews of 19 kindergarten children.

They have competed in 3 samples:

- Theory
- Practice
- Drawing

Efforts for all participants received diplomas and congratulations, the best teams were given awards and prizes of 2 was awarded for creativity.

26 05.2008 contest "ROAD EDUCATION - EDUCATION FOR LIFE" stage area for students of classes I-VIII, which was attended by the 13 winning crews of local phases.

Evidence of competition were:

- Polygon
- Park school

At the end of the contest were awarded diplomas and prizes to participate in the books and money for the best 3 crews.

Winning crew of School "Darius Pop" Satu Mare is the one who represented the county at the national stage, as in 2007.

National competition held in the town Huși Zone Moldova competition in which Satu Mare crew held a valuable place III, won two individual awards.

During 13-17 October 2008 have conducted a series of dedicated "European Day of road safety", in order to sensitize participants on the road the possible consequences of inappropriate behavior in traffic.

Note that became a tradition that began every school year under the leadership of Satu Mare Police to participate in different educational establishments during these events.
