The goals and description of the project:

Overall goal: Changing the society towards more entrepreneurial

Goal: The goal of the project is strengthen sense of initiative, responsibility, discovery, curiosity and creativity in the education process to motivate students to learn educational programs properly and develop skills for the further life by rising students' self-confidence and their entrepreneurial skills.

Students gain great satisfaction, pleasure and perception of the particular subject if there are integrated such activities as research, problem solving, investigation, etc. in the study process. It also raises students' interest in technology and science. A major part of the project is focused on education and methodological support for educationalists and on establishing development networks, experience exchange between participants of the project.

Planned main activities (Methods)

WP 1. Training

Goals: Motivating network members to operate entrepreneurial way; changing the attitude more positive towards entrepreneurship

1.1 Local training and seminars (enterprising methods etc):

Training for teachers, headmasters, network members (according to local needs in every country), e.g. use international experts, e.g mentoring

WP 2. Exchange and seminars

Goals: Networking; Finding the best practices in each country and exchanging them; Motivating the network members

2.1 Teachers exchange (from kindergarden to high schools)

- Study trips: visiting best cases in partner countries
- Exchange of teachers: to e.g. 5 days with partner school to learn new models etc

2.2 Students exchange (with teachers)

- Study trips: visiting schools and common seminars in partner countries – one visit to each country (e.g. Emax)
- Final common fair/ award

2.3 International seminars once per semester and once in each country

- Work shops for teachers, students, headmasters, councilors, politicians

WP 3. Common web page and materials:

Goals: networking, experience exchange and support

- 3.1 Common website for enterprising network, incl. intranet, material bank (also e.g. teacher exchange diaries etc);
- 3.2 Translate already available entrepreneurial teaching material (example: Scotland education programs)
 - According to local needs
- 3.3 Producing of new (marketing) materials for each country (info, success stories etc), to work out our own Entrepreneurial Education teaching materials (methods and stuff)
- 3.4 Start-up package for each school „entrepreneurial packages“ (cameras etc, schools can get out)
 - According to local needs
- 3.5 Common book (internet) about success stories etc.

Leading indicators

- A number of teachers will be trained by specially designed trainings
- A number of teachers will be motivated to work in the entrepreneurial education
- Experience exchange network will be established
- Knowledge platform for teachers will be created
- Self confidence, motivation for the studies and entrepreneurial thinking for a number of the students will increased
